National Literacy Mission Launched At Tihar Jail

NLMA launched Literacy programme for Jail inmates in Tihar Jail on 13 April 2011, which was inaugurated by Chief Justice of Delhi High Court Shri Dipak Mishra & Justice A.K. Sikri. It was felt that illiteracy is one of the reasons for crime, therefore literacy drive was planned with the help of Jail authorities. An analysis done of inmates revealed that illiteracy and crime are directly linked.

illiterates, Those who did not find employment ultimately dragged to criminal activities landed in prison. To stop them from being second time offenders, literacy programme planned make all inmates educated enough to be self-reliant and empowered when out of prison.

Shri Dipak Mishra in his inaugural address appreciated the programme which will impart functional literacy to all illiterate inmates whereby they would become self reliant in reading, writing and numeric.

He further said "many of those lodged in prisoners are not educated. Many might not have committed the crime and landed in the jails. Just because they were not educated enough they could not express their innocence well in the court and thus became victims. All inmates

Capacity Building for Saakshar Bharat Programme

One day workshop was organized by JSS Sindhudurg, Maharashtra on 27th April 2011, on capacity building for Saakshar Bharat Programme. Dr. R.P. Pathak, Consultant NLMA in his inaugural speech mentioned above Saakshar Bharat Programme and dwelt on the need for educating the illiterate sections of society particularly women belonging to SC/ST and



Minorities. He explained in detail the process for identification of volunteers, teachers and motivation of illiterates for successful implementation of the programme, with the involvement of Gram Panchayat.

During the first session, GM, NABARD briefed the participants about the NABARD programmes for village development. Jankidevi Bajaj award winner, Mrs. Shaila Amrute of Ashish Food products and Kanchan Parulekhar shared their experiences as well as methodology adopted for resource mobilization and effective communication. Kanchantai Parulekar of Swayasidda NGO and Dr. Purushottam Suryakant Agashe, Consultant & Development & Dr. Abhay Kudale shared their expertise in the field of running successful NGOs, Communication Skills and Documentation respectively. An exhibition of products made by JSS were displayed in the workshop. Mrs. Uma Prabhu, Chairman JSS Sindhudurg concluded the workshop.
